When you are finished, enjoy over 30 other attractions including the bamboo maze, rope maze, Fun Zone obstacle course, GIANT tube slide and more! (The Hidden Gem Railroad, the Super Megaslide and Gem Mining are **NOT** included with park admission.)

**We will meet as a group at the check-in table at 1:00pm. Please arrive a few minutes early so that we may begin as a group. Once in the park, you are welcome to stay until closing.

Pumpkin picking is available for a fee. Pumpkins are \$.75/lb.—no pumpkin costs more than \$15.00. Don't forget a **flashlight** if you would like to try the maze in the dark and **socks** for the jump pad! The snack bar will be open for food and beverage purchases, but you are permitted to bring your own snacks and drinks, should you choose.
