Louis will also talk about his greatest moment, which was meeting his idol, country singer Shania Twain.

Louis shares his story on the autism spectrum every opportunity he gets to inspire and motivate people. He's passionate in his speeches. He shares his stories very bravely, and organizations have enjoyed him speaking. People have been inspired by his stories around the world.
